Must always be worn by all in the Port Estate in all areas other than designated car parks and administration areas.

Safety Footwear (EN ISO 20345)



Class 3 HI Vis (EN20471:2013)

### Class 3: 2 garments (top & bottom)

- Outdoor staff including agency workers
- Cargo Surveyors
- All Contractors & Sub-contractors



### Class 3: 1 garment (top)

- Admin personnel
- Cargo & Ship Agents
- Visitors (must be accompanied)
- Ships Crew
- Hauliers

## INSTRUCTION & GUIDANCE FOR HAULIERS USING DROGHEDA PORT

Drogheda Port is a busy international shipping port with multiple operators sharing a common workplace with heavy machinery and cargo moving. Your safety whilst at Drogheda Port is very important to us. From the moment you enter the Port of Drogheda, you are required to comply with the Health & Safety Rules designed to ensure that you and other Port users remain safe and injury free.

Drogheda Port is designated a tobacco product (including e-cigarettes), drug, and alcohol-free zone.

YOU ARE responsible for the safety of your own activities which include securing or trimming loads on your vehicle. Under no circumstances is working at height without adequate safety measures (including harnesses, edge protectors and handrails) acceptable.

### MANDATORY: Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

- 1: Class 3 Hi-Vis (ISO20471) (clean and closed)
- 2: Hard Hat (EN 397)
- 3: Safety Footwear (BS EN 345).

#### Must Do

- ✓ observe all of the port safety signage before entering the Port .
- ✓ observe any temporary traffic signs or changes to the port traffic management plan.
- ✓ be familiar with the current Port Traffic Management Plan. Be aware that traffic management plans change for any given day according to operations.
- ✓ comply with all port security (ISPS) requirements and directions
- ✓ be cautious of slippery and wet surfaces when exiting your cab
- ✓ ensure that loads are covered, safe and road legal before leaving the port.
- ✓ drive on the left-hand side of the roadways, unless indicated otherwise.
- ✓ Wear the correct mandatory PPE

#### Must Not

- ✗ Exceed the 20kph Port speed limit (or lower speed limit where otherwise indicated)
- ✗ Enter any cargo storage areas or warehouses unless instructed
- ✗ Stop on yellow hatched lines, pedestrian walkways or other designated "No Parking "areas.
- ✗ Allow passengers or young people under the age of 18 to enter the Port Area
- ✗ Use a mobile telephone whilst driving in the Port
- ✗ Leave your cab without the consent of the operator/supervisor. (It is important that the operator/supervisor has line of sight on you at all times during the loading/unloading operation)
- ✗ Enter the port until after the approved time

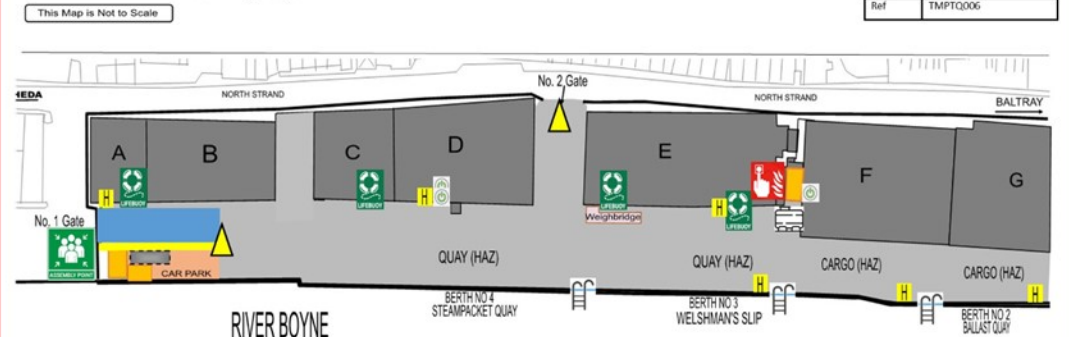
